Governor's Scholars Program	Arkansas	Merit	3.5 GPA, high test scores; maintain a 3.0 GPA in college	Tuition, mandatory fees, room, and board up to \$10,000 per year at an Arkansas institution
Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Program	Florida	Merit	3.5 weighted GPA, required college prep courses, high test scores, and community service	100 percent of tuition and fees plus \$300 per semester for college-related expenses at a Florida public college or a comparable amount to go to a private college
Georgia HOPE Scholarship	Georgia	Merit	High school GPA of 3.0 in a college-prep curriculum	Full tuition at a Georgia public college, approved mandatory fees, and a \$300-per-year book allowance, or \$3,000 per year at a private college
21st Century Scholars Program	Indiana	Need	Low income, pledge of good citizenship, Indiana high school diploma, 2.0 high school GPA, Indiana resident	Four years' tuition at public college in Indiana or a comparable amount for private college
Tuition Opportunity Program for Students (TOPS)	Louisiana	Merit	2.5 GPA and high test scores	Tuition and mandatory fees at a Louisiana public college or a comparable amount for a private college
