New Mexico Scholars Program	New Mexico	Merit and need	Top 5 percent of class or 25 on ACT, family income of less than \$30,000 per year	Tuition, fees, and books for four years at the College of Santa Fe, St. John's College, the College of the Southwest, or a New Mexico public institution
NJ STARS	New Jersey	Merit	Top 20 percent of New Jersey high school class, maintain 3.0 GPA in community college	Up to five semesters of tuition at the local community college
Oklahoma's Promise	Oklahoma	Need	Family income of \$50,000 or less, pass certain high school classes, pledge not to use drugs or alcohol	Tuition at public two- or four-year college, or a comparable amount for an Oklahoma private college
West Virginia PROMISE	West Virginia	Merit	3.0 GPA with college-prep courses, high test scores	Tuition and mandatory fees at any in-state public college or a comparable amount at a private college
Opportunity Grant	Washington	Need	Low income	Tuition, books, transportation, child care, and program materials at any of 10 participating community colleges in Washington State
