Articles of a Treaty made and
concluded by and between Lieutenant General
William T. Sherman, General William S. Harney,
General Alfred H. Terry, General C. C. Augur,
S. B. Henderson, Nathaniel G. Taylor, John B.
Sanborn and Samuel F. Tappan, duly appointed
Commissioners on the part of the United States and
the different Bands of the Sicux Nation of Indians
by their Chiefs and Head men whose names are
hereto subscribed, they being duly authorized to act
in the premises

Article I From this day forward
all war between the parties to this agreement shall forever
cease. The Government of the United States claims peace
and its honor is hereby pledged to keep it. The Indians
claim peace and they now pledge their honor to maintain it.

If bad men among the whites or among other
people, subject to the authority of the United States, shall commit
any wrong upon the person or property of the Indians, the United
States will, upon proof made to the Agent and forwarded to the
Commissioner or Indian Agent at Washington City, prosecute the
cause the offender to be arrested and punished according to the
laws of the United States and also reimburse the injured party
for the loss sustained.

If bad men among the Indians shall commit a
wrong or depredation upon the person or property of any one, white
black or Indian, subject to the authority of the United States and as per
hereto, the Indians hereto named, solemnly agree that they
